WHEREAS, The City of Griffin has agreed to pursue the Regional Water Supply Project and lead participant and to enter into long-term contracts with other participants guaranteeing equitable water rates and allocation of water supply.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:

- \* The City of Concord Mayor and Council wishes to have the future water supply needs of City of Concord included in any allocation of water associated with the proposed Flint River Regional Water Supply Plan; and
- \* The City of Concord Mayor and Council intends to cooperate in the planning and implementation of facilities for the Flint River Regional Water Supply Plan.
