

NOW THEREFORE be it hereby resolved by the Council of the City of Concord as follows:



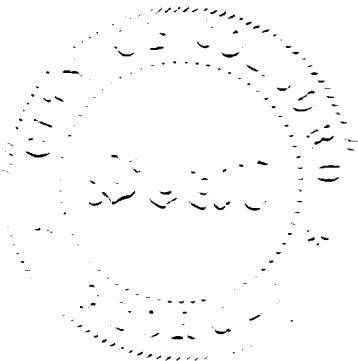
