WHEREAS, the people of Pike County have pursuant to a referendum election held for said purpose elected to impose upon themselves a one percent (1%) local option sales tax.


BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDAINED by the City of Concord that the proceeds from said local option sales tax shall be distributed by the State Revenue Commission among Pike County and the qualifying municipalities therein according to the certificate of distribution attached hereto.


The mayor of the City of Concord is hereby authorized to execute said certificate and file same with the State Revenue Commission as required by law.



CERTIFICATE OF DISTRIBUTION

TO: State Revenue Commissioner

Pursuant to an Act of the Georgia General Assembly, effective January 1, 1980, (Code Ann. §91A-4602), relating to Local Sales & Use Taxes, the governing authorities for the qualifying municipalities and the county located within the special district coterminous with the boundaries of Pike County hereby certify that the proceeds of the combination city/county local sales and use tax generated in such district shall be distributed by the State Revenue Commissioners as follows:

City of Concord shall receive 3.55%.

City of Meansville shall receive 3.41%.

City of Molena shall receive 4.25%.

City of Williamson shall receive 2.8%.

City of Zebulon shall receive 11.26%.

County of Pike shall receive 74.73%.

This certificate shall continue in effect until such time as a new certificate shall be executed as provided in said Act.

By executing this schedule the county and cities, acting through their respective officers, represent that all municipalities lying wholly or partly in the tax jurisdiction have been given an opportunity to show that they are 'qualified municipalities,' as that term is used in the Act, and that all municipalities listed herein as recipients are 'qualified' and so may receive distributions from the proceeds of the tax.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for interim construction financing until said municipal bonds are sold.


