

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY OF CONCORD CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL" ; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONCORD, GEORGIA

Article I

Section 4-2-1 (8) Standard container is hereby amended and shall read as follows: "Standard container means and includes a 96 gallon capacity, durable, rust resistant, nonabsorbent, rodent proof, watertight plastic or metal container with handles or bails, having a tight-fitting cover."

Section 4-2-2 Waste acceptable for collection is hereby amended and shall read as follows: "Garbage and rubbish constitute waste acceptable for collection by the city."

Section 4-2-4 Preparation and storage of acceptable waste; (a) is hereby amended and shall read as follows: "(a). The owner or occupant of each residence or business or commercial establishment shall store acceptable waste in standard container(s) which shall be provided by the sanitation company contracted with the city. Each owner or occupant shall prevent the continued, excessive and unsightly accumulation of waste upon the property occupied."

Section 4-2-4 Preparation and storage of acceptable waste; (b) is hereby amended to read as follows: "(b). All acceptable waste must be placed inside a garbage bag and placed inside the container provided."

Section 4-2-5 Place of collection; grass clippings; limbs is hereby deleted in its entirety.

Article II

Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. Except as otherwise provided herein, all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

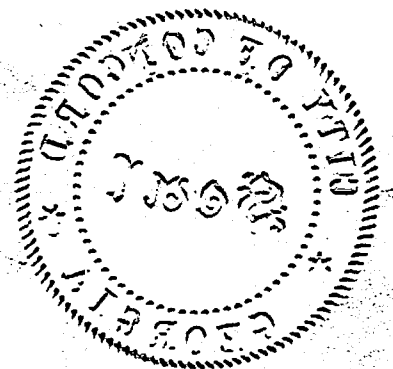

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-03

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE CODIFICATION AND PUBLICATION OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CONCORD, GEORGIA, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, The City of Concord, Georgia ("City") is a Municipal Corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.26(b) of the City Charter requires the City to publish the general codification of all ordinances of the City having the force and effect of law; and

WHEREAS, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is *The Code of the City of Concord, Georgia* (hereinafter "the Code"), that contains all of the ordinances previously adopted by the City Council (the originals of which are available for inspection at City Hall); and

WHEREAS, the Code is only a rewrite and republication of ordinances that have been previously adopted by the City Council and does not change or alter any of the ordinances contained therein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt the attached copy of the Code as the official codification of the City's ordinances and to publish the attached copy of the Code as the City's official code book.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF CONCORD, GEORGIA**

SECTION 1. General Codification Adopted. *The Code of the City of Concord, Georgia*, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted as the general codification of all ordinances of the City and shall be published promptly and a copy furnished to all officers, departments and agencies of the City and made available to the public.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the State of Georgia.

SECTION 3.

A. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that all sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are and were, upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.

B. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is severable from every other Section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. It is hereby further declared to be the intention of the City Council that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other Section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

C. In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the City Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of the Ordinance and that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining Sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional, enforceable, and of full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City; however, the effective date of the individual ordinances contained in the Code shall remain the dates said ordinances were adopted by the City Council (the originals of which are on file and available for inspection at City Hall).
